

SUPERINTENDENT'S LETTER 24th July 2023

I write this having had a weekend of farewells and the end of another chapter in my book of adventures. I'm blessed to look forward to the beginning of a new chapter in September as I join the Cannock Chase Circuit as your Superintendent.

As we begin this part of our journey together, we begin the new Connexional year for which the theme chosen by the president and vice-president is "Hidden Treasure". It was a joy to hear their addresses at Methodist Conference in June as they spoke with excitement and conviction of the treasures that God hides for us, not from us. God's treasures are all around us if we take time to notice them in his creation, his people, his world. They may be small and buried, but they are ours to find if we look. The theme uses the text from Isaiah 45:3 which falls neatly in the story of Cyrus who God has appointed, even though he's not an Israelite, to instruct the Israelites in exile in Babylon to return to Israel and rebuild the temple. No mean feat with the weight of what that represents for the people of Israel. As they begin to build, they find buried treasure, buried there by King Herod. Treasures are no good to us if they're buried, except perhaps that they're safe. But God doesn't call us so that we are safe. He calls us to take risks, to explore and dig, with all the messiness that might hold, as we deepen our discipleship, finding his treasures along the way.

It feels timely in the Methodist Church to have this theme. Perhaps we need to let go of some of the things that we think are very important so that the buried treasure in those places, activities and people can be found. We remember as we share the sacraments each month all that God has done for us, and we should be reminded of all that he longs to do for us. Jeremiah 29:11 tells says: "For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope." (NSRV). I'm sure that when the temple was destroyed, the people struggled to see a future with any hope. But then look what God did for them. Not only did they get a new temple, but they had also enough of everything they needed to build it and resource it. It wasn't easy, in fact it was thwarted with difficulty, but by the grace of God it happened because that was the will of God.

As we begin our Connexional year together, let's remember all that God has and will do for us, never leaving or forsaking us. As we seek to live in God's will, let's be bold and courageous as we seek out and find the treasure that God is hiding for us. I feel like this is the beginning of a great treasure hunt – and they're always exciting!

I and my family are very much looking forward to what the next chapter holds. I have no doubt that it will be exciting and challenging in equal measure, but we don't do any of this in our own strength. We have God's helper, the paraclete, the Holy Spirit to keep and guide us in right paths.

With every blessing and many thanks for all you do, whoever you are and wherever you ioin in with God's work.


