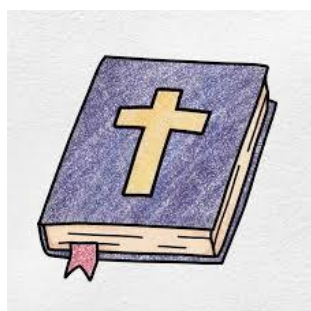
24th February 10am we shall be prayer walking round the community served by Featherstone

24th March 10am we shall be walking around the community served by TWC followed by a simple lunch

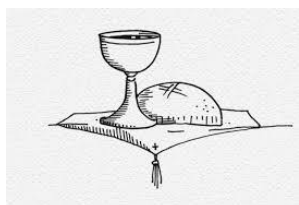
Every day the Staff Team are offering the opportunity for anyone and everyone to gather for a simple lunch followed by a short act of worship. during Holy Week.

Monday 30th March @ 1pm, our Circuit Operations Manager, Karen Brown will be offering an introduction to Holy Week



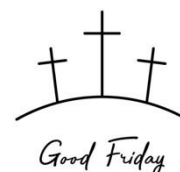
Tuesday 31st March @ 1pm, there will be a community reading of the good news that Mark recorded in his gospel led by Rev Sam
